To receive credit for the ME or ISyE Seminar, students are required to register for the appropriate course and attend **12** lectures during Fall semester. *The lectures must be selected from those sponsored by the Mechanical Engineering Department and IsyE Program as listed on the course web site.* Students registered for ME 8773/8774 must attend at least 8 of the lectures listed as Main Series plus 4 additional lectures. Students registered for ISyE 8773/8774 must attend all 5 of the ISyE lectures plus 7 additional lectures.
